Westminster Shorter Catechism, Q&A 14-16

Reader: What is sin?

People: Sin is any want of conformity unto, or transgression of, the law of God.

Reader: What was the sin whereby our first parents fell from the estate wherein they were created?

People: The sin whereby our first parents fell from the estate wherein they were created, was their eating the forbidden fruit.

Reader: Did all mankind fall in Adam's first transgression?

People: The covenant being made with Adam, not only for himself, but for his posterity; all mankind, descending from him by ordinary generation, sinned in him, and fell with him, in his first transgression.

CONFESSION OF SIN

All: We confess to You, O God,

**that we have sinned against heaven and in Your sight,
and are not worthy to be called Your children.
We have forgotten You, and have broken Your holy laws.
We have been wayward and disobedient.
We have been selfish and unkind.
For the sake of Your dear Son, our Savior,
we beseech You to pardon our sins,
