People: Prayer is an offering up of our desires unto God, for things agreeable to His will, in the name of Christ, with confession of our sins, and thankful acknowledgment of His mercies. Reader: What rule hath God given for our direction in prayer? People: The whole Word of God is of use to direct us in prayer; but the special rule of direction is that form of prayer which Christ taught His disciples, commonly called the Lord's Prayer. Confession of Sin adapted from Every Moment Holy O Lord, we confess our disordered desires, our lust to indulge in things that war against our own hearts and the hearts of those we love. O Christ, take our desires and let them be subsumed in still greater desire for You, until there remains no room for lesser cravings. Faced with temptation, we would rather choose You, Jesus— But we are weak. So be our strength. We are shadowed. Be our light. We are selfish. Remake us now, and refashion our desires

according to the better designs of Your love. Amen.
